Facilitating Transformational Climate Investment

Mr. Pa Ousman Jarju is Director of GCF's Country Programming Division where he supports developing countries to plan, identify, design and implement country-driven, transformational climate investment. Prior to this, he was the Gambian Minister of Environment, Climate Change and Natural Resources and served as the Chair of the Least Developed Countries (LDC) Group to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). Pa Ousman was Special Climate Change Envoy of the Gambia and has extensive diplomatic experience across the 47 LDCs, China, the U.S. and the EU. He has gained wide-ranging managerial experience in the Gambia's Department of Water Resources as its Director and then the overseeing Minister. **Mr. Tony Clamp** is Director of the GCF's Private Sector Facility where he leads its equity and debt investment program in renewable energy, e-mobility, climate finance and private equity fuds globally, managing portfolio of USD 2.8 billion. He has 30+ years experience in private equity, sustainable infrastructure investment/project and climate finance and SME investing. Tony spent ten years with the International Finance Corporation in Washington, DC where he managed SME investment fund for Africa and led the development of privatization in e-transportation and water sectors in Africa, Asia and Latin America. He held a number of senior positions with private fund managers, including with CVC Capital Partners and IFM Investors, and was Head of Project Finance at Thames Water.
